Transformation Definition

A profound change in form from one stage to the next in the life history of an organism A Transformation by the Holy Spirit Definition;

"A profound and permanent change in an aspect of one's character and/or heart, from 'fleshiness' into Christlikeness"

Principle #3

God's goal is genuine, profound spiritual transformation not powerless imitation.

Principle #5

God's transformation requires our co-operation and our surrender.



Principle #6

God's transformative work in us is a result of His unconditional love for us.

Philippians 1:6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

You may have a bunch of overwhelming issues that are making it difficult to keep your head above water. You may be thinking that everything seems to be stacked against you.

Right Now.... You may feel defeated. You may feel like giving up. You may think that God just doesn't want to give you a break. You may believe that you're destined to live a much harder life compared to most.

But the reality is that God is in the process of providing you opportunities for transformation. God does that, because He cares more about your character and your heart than your comfort, your job, or anything else you value.

The Lord cares about your character and your heart more than anything else, because He knows that you will be taking your character and your heart into eternity, not your job, not your things, and not your achievements.

Principle #7

God allows the challenges and difficulties you are facing today, because if you allow Him, He will lead you through the messy and unrefined parts of your character and your heart.
