let your ear be attentive and your eyes open to hear the prayer your servant is praying before you day and night for your servants, the people of Israel.

I confess that we have sinned against you. Yes, even my own family and I have sinned!

We have acted very wickedly toward you. We have not obeyed the commands, decrees and laws you gave your servant Moses.

Getting Started Right requires

- Seeking Trusted Honest
 Evaluations from Outside
 Perspectives in the Know.
- Stillness with God: Time to Mourn and Meditate
- Prayer: Confession and Intercession

Principle #2

Principle #3

Getting started right with God requires stillness with God. We need time to mourn, contemplate, understand, and heal from our difficult experiences, seasons, pains, and wounds.

Getting started right with God requires a genuine and disciplined prayer life. Our prayers must consist of both confession and intercession.
