
For the Work of THE Ministry



Ephesians 4:1-16

Ephesians 4:1

Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God.

Ephesians 4:2 Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.

Ephesians 4:3

Make every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit, binding yourselves together with the bond of peace.

Ephesians 4:4

For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.

Ephesians 4:5 There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism,

Ephesians 4:6 one God and Father of all, who is over all, in all, and living through all.

Ephesians 4:7 However, he has given each one of us a special grace according to the measure of Christ's gift.

Ephesians 4:8 That is why the Scriptures say, "When he ascended to the heights, he led a crowd of captives, and gave gifts to his people."

Ephesians 4:9

Notice that it says "he ascended." This clearly means that Christ also descended to our lowly world.

Ephesians 4:10 And the same one who descended is the one who ascended higher than all the heavens, so that he might fill all things.

Ephesians 4:11 So Christ himself gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers

Ephesians 4:12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, and for the building up of the body of Christ.


Ephesians 4:13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

Ephesians 4:14 Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of doctrine. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth.

Ephesians 4:15 Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.

Ephesians 4:16 He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.

Understanding Unity Unity is something that the Holy Spirit gives; it does not need to be created. Disunity is rooted in the sins of \bullet pride and idolatry. We must eagerly desire it and make every effort to keep it.

Understanding Unity Unity does not mean that individuality and individual responsibility are lost. Unity among diverse groups is at the heart of the gospel and evidence of God's power and wisdom.

Principle #3

Being equipped as Saints requires that every individual participates in the work of THE ministry, in accordance with the gifts they have been given by God.

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THE Ministry

The intentional focus and realized actions of expressing, sharing, and spreading our Christian faith with others, for others, and to others for the express purpose of obeying the Great Commission.

Principle #4

The equipping of the Saints for the work of THE ministry is the responsibility of Faithful, **Biblically Qualified, Spiritual** Leaders who are Christ's Gifts to the Church.

Ephesians 4:16a He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work,


Being equipped as Saints requires that each individual in the body be busy speaking the truth in love through the special work God has given them to do.
