The Antonine Plague Also known as the Plague of Galen was an ancient pandemic in 165-180 AD brought to the **Roman Empire by troops** returning from campaigns in the Near East.

The Antonine Plague **Roman Historian Dio Cassiu** (155-235) estimated that at that the height of the plague there were 2,000 deaths per day. Around 5 million deaths total. 25% Mortality Rate.

The Cyprian Plague A plague that occurred between 250-262 BC. The cause of the plague is highly speculative due to sparse sourcing, but suspects include smallpox, pandemic influenza, or viral hemorrhagic fever like the Ebola virus.

The Cyprian Plague Its modern name comes from St. Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, an early Christian writer who witnessed and described the plague. Estimated 5,000 deaths per day at the height of the plague.

Dionysius "Most of our brother-Christians showed unbounded love and loyalty, never sparing themselves and thinking only of one another. Heedless of the danger, they took charge of the sick, attending to their every need and ministering

Dionysius to them in Christ, and with them departed this life serenely happy; for they were infected by others with the disease, drawing on themselves the sickness of their neighbours and cheerfully accepting their pains."
