Principle #1

God loves the world.

"World" [kosmos] Defined

- John's Gospel 72 Times
- John's Letters 24 Times
- Context: the realm of humanity that is in opposition to God.
- Judaism rarely spoke of God's love for anyone outside of them, let alone for "sinners".

But doesn't the Bible say...

- That God hates sin?
- That God will pour out His wrath on His enemies?
- That God gets angry with those who disobey Him or reject Him?
- That God is going to judge the world?

Parallel Truths

God feels both love and anger towards those who reject Him, ignore Him, disobey Him, and willfully sin against Him. Every parent knows what that is like. Anyone who has genuinely loved knows what it is like to feel both anger and love toward a person.

Principle #1

Would you be willing to sacrifice the person you love the most for the person you hate the most, especially if they don't deserve it? Especially if they won't even be thankful?

When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners.

Now, most people would not be willing to die for a righteous person, though someone might perhaps be willing to die for a person who is especially good.

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation.

For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son.

So now we can rejoice in our wonderful new relationship with God because our Lord Jesus Christ has made us friends of God.
