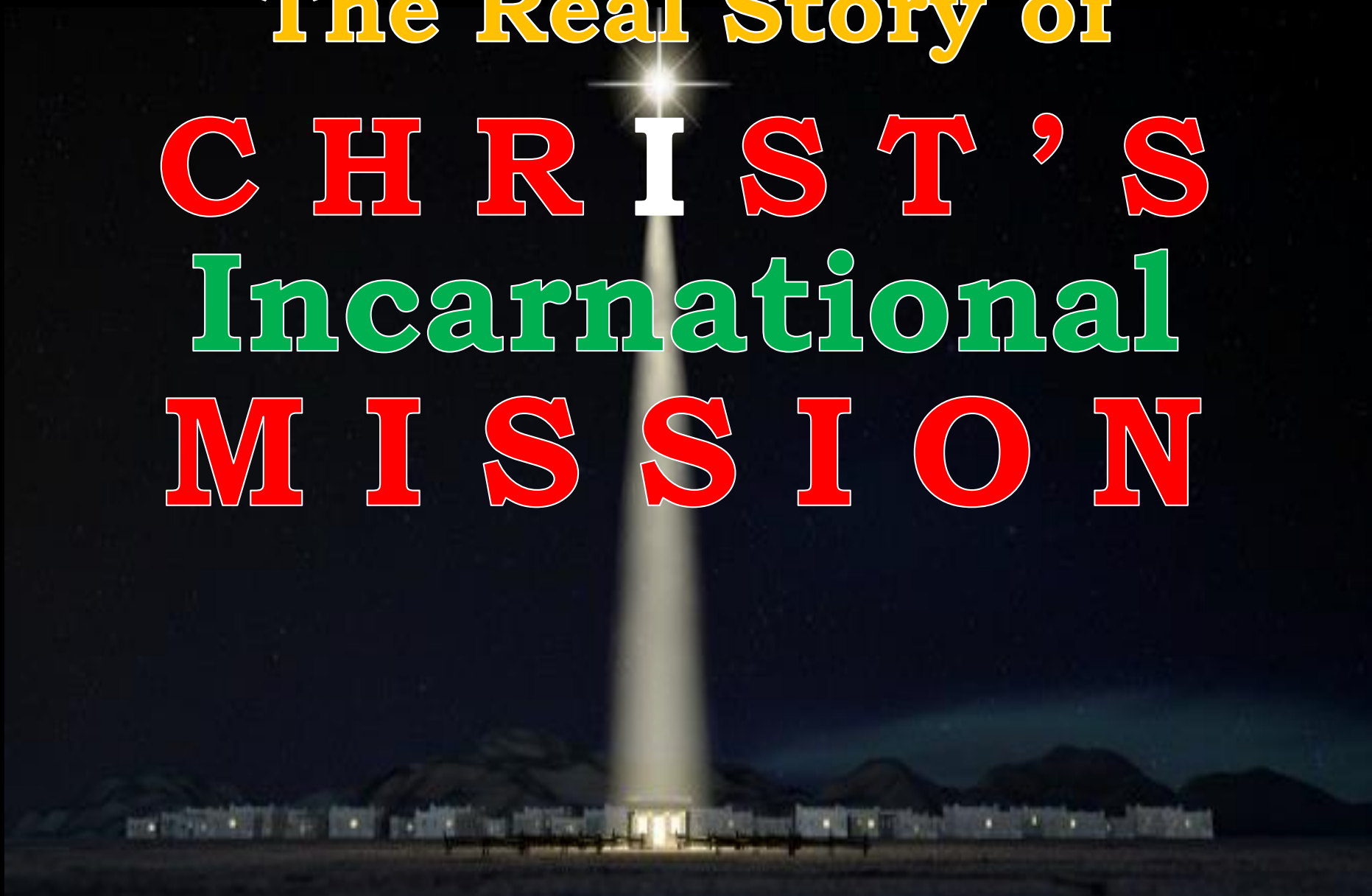

Matthew 1:18

This is how Jesus the Messiah was born.

Matthew 1:19

which means ‘God is with us.’”**

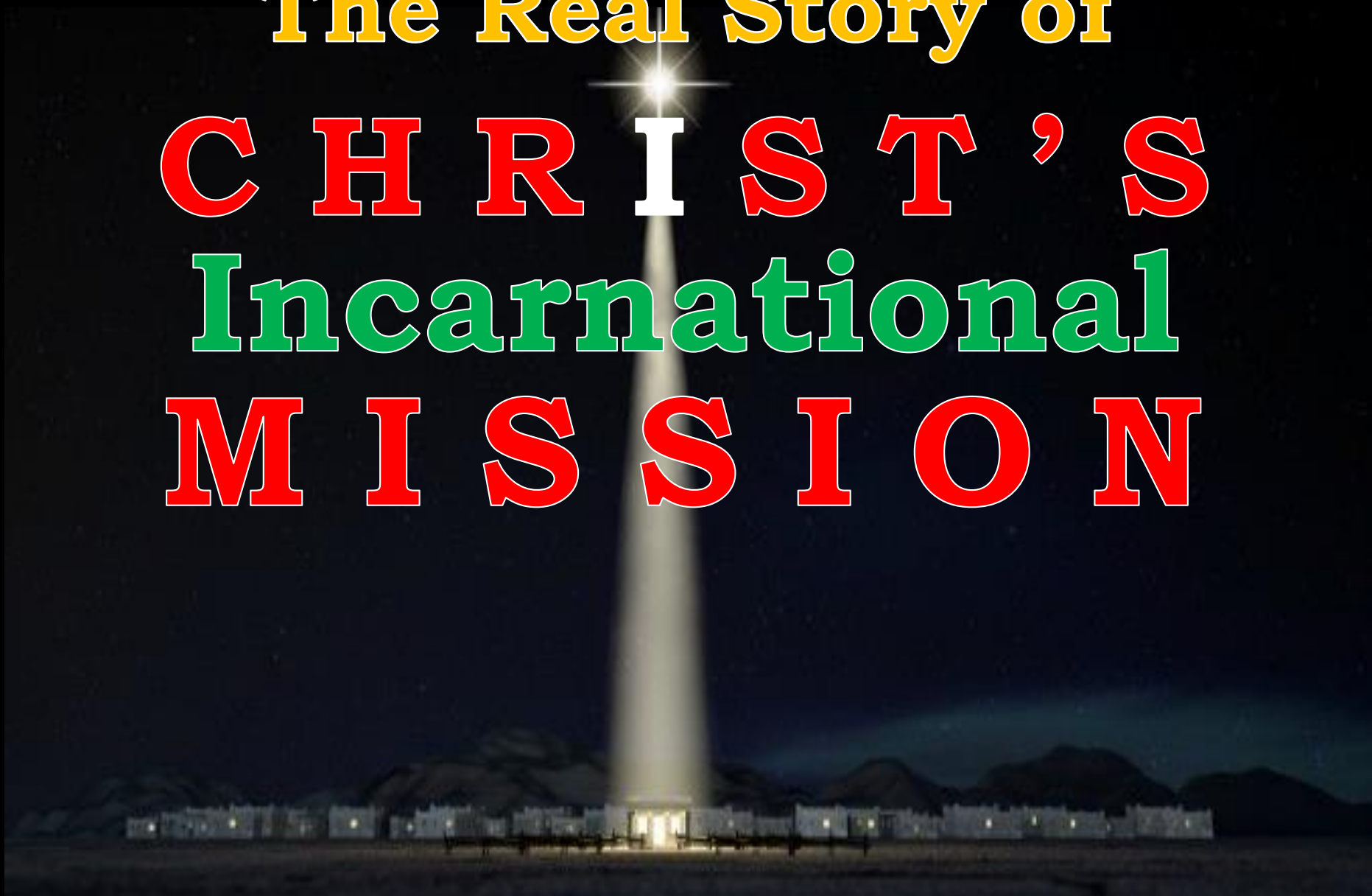

A significant disturbance that interrupts and impacts someone or something to the extent that it legitimately creates permanent, radical change.

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Systems of Belief

- **God loves the world, which includes those who hate, reject, and disobey Him.**
- **Through Jesus Christ, God reveals Himself and His attributes such as: His heart, mind, love, mercy, forgiveness, etc.**
- **What it looks like to be blessed and highly favored by God.**

Systems of Belief

- **God's upside down and backwards Kingdom.**
- **The type of people that God calls and chooses to magnify and glorify His name.**
- **Believing, following, and obeying God means your life will be intentionally and radically disrupted by Him.**

Principle #2
