- Was married briefly at the age of 16.
- Met Danny Garrett at age of 21

On 6/13/83, after a weekend binger on drugs, she joined her boyfriend and another friend in a home invasion robbery of another friend.

Events escalated and Karla used a 3-foot pickaxe to murder two people, amassing a total of 28 strikes between both bodies. Sentenced to death in 1984.

Gave her life to Jesus in 10/83. Lived as a model prisoner and as a Christian for 14 years before her execution. Married the prison chaplain 95.
