2 Samuel 16:5

As King David came to Bahurim, a man came out of the village cursing them. It was Shimei son of Gera, from the same clan as Saul's family.

Principle #4

Christ empowered deliverance and freedom requires above all else a genuine trust in God, in His goodness, and in His sovereignty.

Principle #5

Christ empowered deliverance and freedom allows us to perceive the connectedness of our personal sins with sins that are later committed against us and those we love dearly.

Principle #6

If you discover you are not living free in the Spirit of Jesus, you need to ask Him for His supernatural deliverance.

Seeking Deliverance

- **Identification**
- **Confession**
- **Forgiveness**
- **Give It to God for Destruction**
- **Repentance**

Seeking Deliverance

- **Receive Gods Truth. Believe that God can and will redeem it.**
- **Ask God to seal the victory and to produce good spiritual fruit in this area. Ask for Restoration.**
