Guilt Defined

The fact of having committed an offense or crime. A legitimate guilty feeling is the result of being convicted that you did something wrong.

Shame Desined

A painful emotion of humiliation or distress that is the result of believing your whole person is wrong. The belief that you are inferior or unworthy as a person.

Illegitimate Symonyms

Counterfeit, False, Fraudulent, Unnecessary, Unhealthy, Unwarranted

- You feel guilty but do not know why. The reason is vague or hazy.
- Has nothing to do with what is true or accurate.
- Leads you towards self condemnation instead of conviction.

- Cannot be solved through forgiveness or repentance.
- Rooted in a deep seeded insecurity.
- Can be a manifestation of a deeply seeded fear of rejection.

- Leads to spiritual cataracts; it hinders you from seeing yourself and your relationship with God and others clearly.
- Is the result of overly critical and particularly harsh self-judgement.

- Causes you to carry around unbearable burdens that no one can carry.
- Prevents you from giving others healthy doses of Vitamin N – "No".

Legitimate guilt and shame are gifts from God to help us find our way back toward what is right, and they help motivate us to change.

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More often than not, illegitimate guilt and illegitimate shame are the byproducts of False Evidence Appearing Real

You will never be free to enjoy the sovereignty of God in your life so long as you are influenced by illegitimate guilt and shame.

Illegitimate guilt and shame are allowed to reign when we are more aware of our sin than we are of God's supernatural love, grace, mercy, kindness, and forgiveness.

Only a Christ centered community of little Christs can help you inspect all of your feelings of guilt and shame as you bring them to the cross of Jesus Christ.

The only cure for illegitimate guilt and illegitimate shame is the gospel of Jesus Christ.
