Spiritual Transformation

A profound and permanent change in one's character, heart, mind, and/or soul that is the direct result of God's supernatural power.

Spiritual Transformation

It is the process by which God forms Christ's character in believers through the power and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Principle #1

Continuous, personal, radical Holy Spirit empowered transformation is a requirement for entrance into the Kingdom of Heaven.

John 3:1 - NLT There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee.

John 3:2

After dark one evening, he came to speak with Jesus. "Rabbi," he said, "we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with you."

John 3:3 Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God."

John 3:4

"What do you mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?"

Principle #3

There are times when God will only release His blessings on us after a season of prolonged pain, suffering, and brokenness that we experience as God wrestles with us.
