Principle #2

Sharing the Gospel and making disciples for Christ is all about being faithful and obeying the Lord's command.

Matthew 28:20

How can we make disciples for Christ and then teach them to obey all that Christ has commanded, when we ourselves are not obeying Him with regards to sharing the Gospel and making disciples in the first place?

Principle #2

Sharing the Gospel and making disciples for Christ is all about being faithful and obeying the Lord's command.

Principle #3

Once we decide to obey God by sharing the Gospel in order to make disciples for Christ, we must remember to do it His way.

Principle #4

Philippians 2:5

You must have the same attitude
that Christ Jesus had.

Philippians 2:6

Though he was God, Christ did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

Philippians 2:7

Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being.

Philippians 2:8

When he appeared in human form,
he humbled himself in obedience
to God and died a criminal's death
on a cross.

Principle #4

Making disciples requires that we develop the Christlike attitude of being willing to give up our rights and privileges for the sake of helping others embrace the message of Jesus Christ.

Principle #5

Sharing the Gospel in order to make disciples requires that we be intentional, focused, and incarnational in our relationships with the lost.

Principle #6

Sharing the Gospel to make disciples is all about asking the Holy Spirit to lead us, guide us, and show us where He is already working so that we can join Him in His work.

Principle #7

Making disciples requires that we learn to make peace with a lack of results and to celebrate apparent failure in the short term as long as we are actively sharing the Gospel in a Christlike way.
