Part 6 If You Don't, Who Will?

Romans 10:9 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:10

For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

Romans 10:11 As the Scriptures tell us, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced."

Romans 10:12 Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They have the same Lord, who gives generously to all who call on him.

Romans 10:21 But regarding Israel, God said, "All day long I opened my arms to them, but they were disobedient and rebellious."

Part 6 If You Don't, Who Will?

Principle #1

Romans 9:1 With Christ as my witness, I speak with utter truthfulness. My conscience and the Holy Spirit confirm it.

Romans 9:2

My heart is filled with bitter sorrow and unending grief for my people, my Jewish brothers and sisters.

Romans 9:3 I would be willing to be forever cursed—cut off from Christ!—if that would save them.

Romans 9:4a They are the people of Israel, chosen to be God's adopted children. God revealed his glory to them. He made covenants with them and gave them his law.

Romans 9:4b He gave them the privilege of worshiping him and receiving his wonderful promises.

Romans 9:5

Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob are their ancestors, and Christ himself was an Israelite as far as his human nature is concerned. And he is God, the one who rules over everything and is worthy of eternal praise! Amen.

The beauty of the feet that we are talking about here is not that of soft, freshly washed, nice smelling, manicured, painted, well tanned feet.

No, the beautiful feet we are talking about here are the filthy, smelly, worn, cracked, wrinkled, leathery, bloody, and scarred feet that have worked through and suffered many hardships as they have gone to all places and to all people in hopes of helping them be saved.

Principle #4

The Murder of Kitty Genovese



"37 WHO SAW MURDER DIDN'T CALL THE POLICE" - The New York Times March 27, 1964

March 13, 1964 she was murdered in front of her home. She parked in front of her home and a man ran up behind her and stabbed her in the back, twice.

Kitty screamed for help and a neighbor responded shouting at the criminal "Let that girl alone!" Her attacker ran off and **Kitty began crawling towards** her apartment.

 Several witnesses saw the attack and saw the man jump in his car and drive off. 10 minutes later the man returned to the scene of the crime...

• Seeing Kitty lying on the ground almost unconscious, he proceeded to stab her several more times, then he stole her money, and then he sexually assaulted her.

 A neighbor finally phoned the police and an ambulance arrived but it was too late to help Kitty.

 38 neighbors in total witnessed the crimes committed against Kitty but 37 of them stood by and did nothing.

The Bystander Effect

Research has shown that, even in an emergency, most bystanders are less likely to help a victim when there are other bystanders present, compared to when they are the only bystander.

Principle #7

If you don't share the Good News with them, no one will.
