# **Knowing Your Own Story of Transformation**

# Ezekiel 37:1

The hand of the Lord was upon me, and He brought me out by the Spirit of the Lord and set me down in the middle of the valley, and it was full of bones.

# Ezekiel 37:2

And He caused me to pass among them round about, and behold, there were very many on the surface of the valley; and lo, they were very dry.

# Ezekiel 37:3

And He said to me, “Son of man, can these bones live?” And I answered, “O Lord God, Thou knowest.”

# Ezekiel 37:4

Again He said to me,  
“Prophecy over these bones,  
and say to them, ‘O dry bones,  
hear the word of the Lord.’”

# Ezekiel 37:5

“Thus says the Lord God to these bones, ‘Behold, I will cause breath to enter you that you may come to life.

# Ezekiel 37:6

‘And I will put sinews on you,  
make flesh grow back on you,  
cover you with skin, and put  
breath on you that you may come  
alive; and you will know that  
I am the Lord.’”

# Ezekiel 37:7

So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold, a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to its bone.

# **Ezekiel 37:8**

**And I looked, and behold, sinews were on them, and flesh grew, and skin covered them; but there was no breath in them.**

# Ezekiel 37:9

Then He said to me, “Prophecy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, ‘Thus says the Lord God, “Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they come to life.””

# **Ezekiel 37:10**

**So I prophesied as He commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they came to life, and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army.**

# Principle #1

**Sharing the Gospel of Jesus is  
proclaiming destiny in the midst of  
failure and brokenness.**

**Sharing the Gospel is proclaiming  
restored relationship with God.**

# Principle #3

**Deeply understanding your own  
“valley of dry bones” is a  
foundational expression  
of your testimony.**

# Principle #4

**A deep relationship and trust in God's power aligns your heart to His authority.**

# Ezekiel 37:3

And He said to me, “Son of man, can these bones live?” And I answered, “O Lord God, Thou knowest.”

# Principle #5

**We are called to be an ambassador  
of reconciliation between  
brokenness and a relationship  
with God.**

# **2 Corinthians 5:18**

**Now all these things are from God,  
who reconciled us to Himself  
through Christ, and gave us the  
ministry of reconciliation.**

## **2 Corinthians 5:19**

**Namely, that God was in Christ  
reconciling the world to Himself, not  
counting their trespasses against  
them, and He has committed to us  
the word of reconciliation.**

## **2 Corinthians 5:20**

**Therefore, we are ambassadors  
for Christ as though God were  
entreating through us; we beg  
you on behalf of Christ,  
be reconciled to God.**

**As a believer in Christ, God has transformed your very being to be a witness to His great love.**
