# Part 6 Prayers of Agreement and Praying Together

### 1 John 5:13

I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life.

### 1 John 5:14

#### And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him.

### 1 John 5:15

And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for.

#### Exodus 2:23

#### **Exodus 2:24**

#### **Revelation 6:9**

### **Revelation 6:10** They called out in a loud voice, "How long, Sovereign Lord, holy and true, until you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood?"

#### **Revelation 6:11**

Then each of them was given a white robe, and they were told to wait a little longer, until the full number of their fellow servants, their brothers and sisters, were killed just as they had been.
