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1 Samuel 3:2

One night Eli, who was almost blind by now, had gone to bed.

The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was sleeping in the Tabernacle near the Ark of God.

"Yes?" Samuel replied. "What is it?"

1 Samuel 3:5 He got up and ran to Eli. "Here I am. Did you call me?"

"I didn't call you," Eli replied. "Go back to bed." So he did.

Then the Lord called out again, "Samuel!" Again Samuel got up and went to Eli. "Here I am. Did you call me?"

"I didn't call you, my son," Eli said. "Go back to bed."

Samuel did not yet know the Lord because he had never had a message from the Lord before.

So the Lord called a third time, and once more Samuel got up and went to Eli. "Here I am. Did you call me?"

Then Eli realized it was the Lord who was calling the boy.

So he said to Samuel, "Go and lie down again, and if someone calls again, say, 'Speak, Lord, your servant is listening." So Samuel went back to bed.

1 Samuel 3:10 And the Lord came and called as before, "Samuel! Samuel!"

And Samuel replied, "Speak, your servant is listening."

1 Samuel 3:11 Then the Lord said to Samuel, "I am about to do a shocking thing in Israel.

I am going to carry out all my threats against Eli and his family, from beginning to end.

1 Samuel 3:13

I have warned him that judgment is coming upon his family forever, because his sons are blaspheming God and he hasn't disciplined them.

So I have vowed that the sins of Eli and his sons will never be forgiven by sacrifices or offerings."



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Principle #1

God has called you; He has been calling you, and He will continue to call you in the future.

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is GOD Calling ME?



answering the question every believer asks



A specific message from God directly to you that is clearly distinguishable from your own inner voice or the voice of others. It is not a common event and can come in many ways, shapes, and forms.

Abram's Calls

- The Lord had said to Gen 12:1
- The Lord appeared to 12:7
- The Lord said to Abram 13:14
- The Lord spoke to Abram in a
 - vision and said to him 15:1
 - The Lord appeared to 17:1

God's call is most often heard Spirit to spirit so it can be hard to quantify at times. God's call is an unmistakable, profound expression, and an inner experience that you know is real.

- It brings with it new information and new responsibility.
 - When God calls, it means it is
 - your turn to get involved.
 - God's call establishes boundaries for your life.

It means you will say yes to certain things and no to others. It means anything incompatible with obeying the call must be rejected in pursuit of the call.

God's Call Defined

It establishes specific barriers, parameters, parenthesis, and guidelines for your life. Those who accept the call are able to find contentment within God's imposed limitations.

God's Call Defined

God always calls His people to someone, something, or somewhere but not before He calls us to Himself first. The greatest place to be, is in the center of God's call.

God's Call Defined

God's call will always go from universal to specific, from previous to current, builds on the past, fulfills the present, and completes the whole.

4 Primary Ways He Calls

- A sudden experience
- A reasoned decision
- The prompting of others
- Blended successive experiences of the previous 3.

God has called you; He has been calling you, and He will continue to call you in the future.

God has called everyone who has genuinely placed their faith in Him to communicate with Him directly and to hear His voice.

- Do you believe correctly? Are you misinformed theologically?
 - Do you believe that God still speaks today?
 - Has anyone ever taught you how to hear God?

Do you believe that God wants to personally and specifically communicate with you? Do you understand that you are expected to have a personal relationship with God?

Do you realize it takes time, effort, and focus to invest in relationship? Are you too busy? Do you fail to implement and practice quietness, stillness and listening in your spiritual life?

- Have you allowed life to deafen your ears to the Master's voice?
- Are the voices of your desires
 - louder than His voice?
 - Do you actively read and understand the Bible?

Are you living in outright sin or disobedience towards the Lord and His ways? Have you purposefully deafened your ears to His voice because you don't want to hear Him?

Background

Background

Samuel is Hannah's son. Hannah prayed and begged God for a son, and He answered her prayer. In turn, Hannah dedicated Samuel to the Lord and to the priesthood from birth.

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Matthew 7:21

Not everyone who calls out to me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter.

Matthew 7:22

On judgment day many will say to me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in your name and cast out demons in your name and performed many miracles in your name.'

Matthew 7:23

But I will reply, 'I never knew you. Get away from me, you who break God's laws.'

But Eli called out to him, "Samuel, my son." "Here I am," Samuel replied.

1 Samuel 3:17 "What did the Lord say to you? Tell me everything. And may God strike you and even kill you if you hide anything from me!"

l Samuel 3:18So Samuel told Eli everything; he didn't hold anything back. "It is the Lord's will," Eli replied. "Let him do what he thinks best."

Principle #6

Principle #7

The more you hear, listen to, and obey what God speaks to you personally, the more He will continue to share with you.

As Samuel grew up, the Lord was with him, and everything Samuel said proved to be reliable.

The Lord continued to appear at Shiloh and gave messages to Samuel there at the Tabernacle.

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
