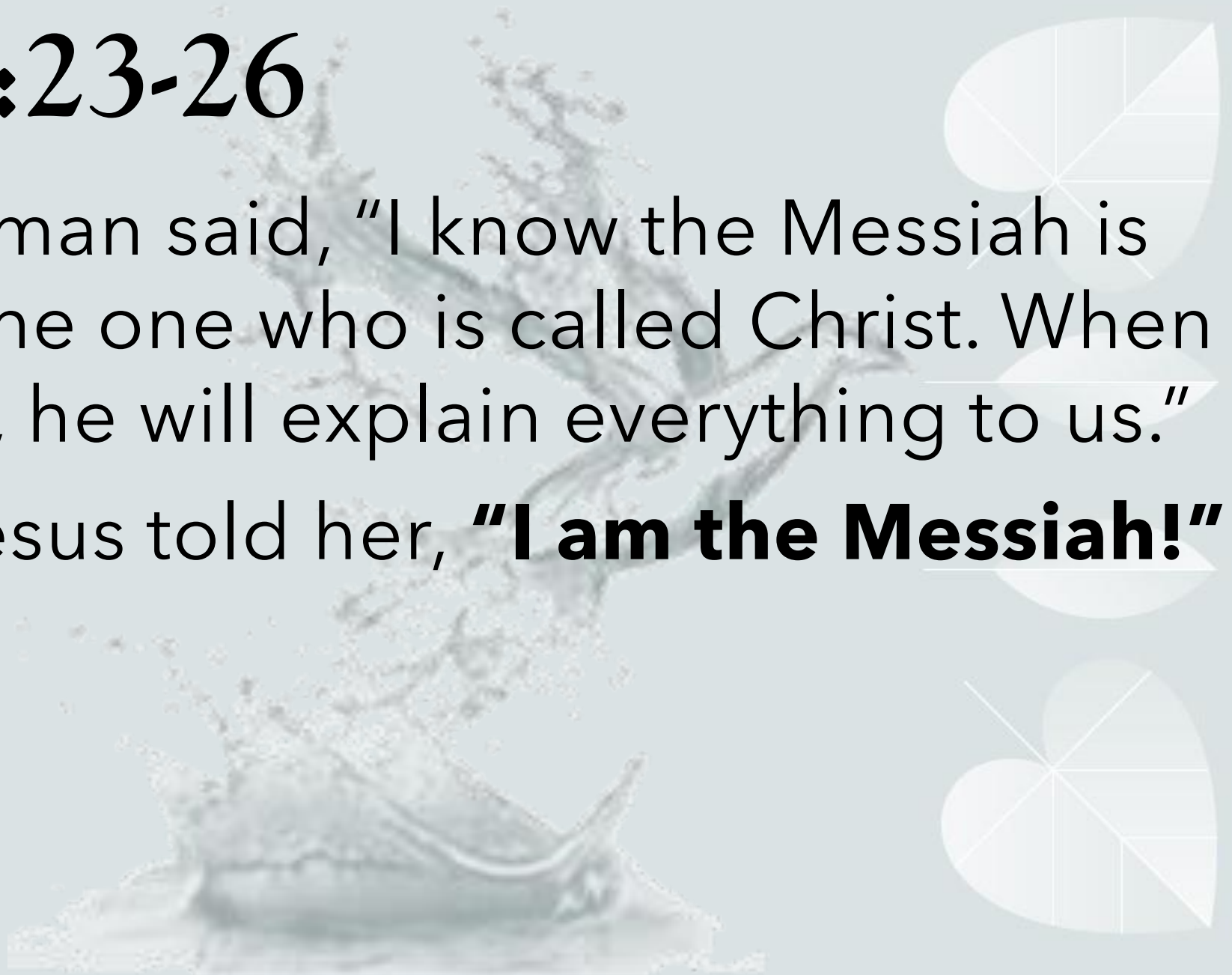
John 4:23-26



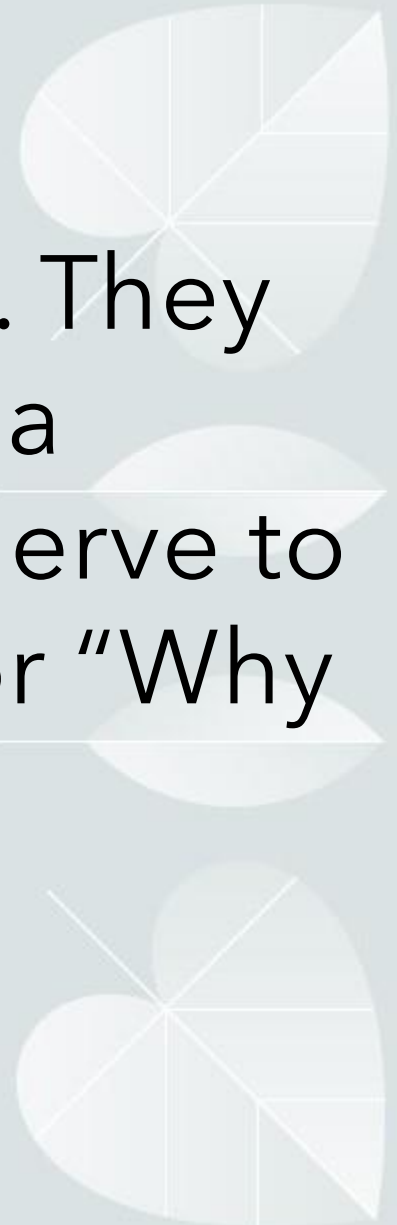


John 4:27-38

The Woman Messenger

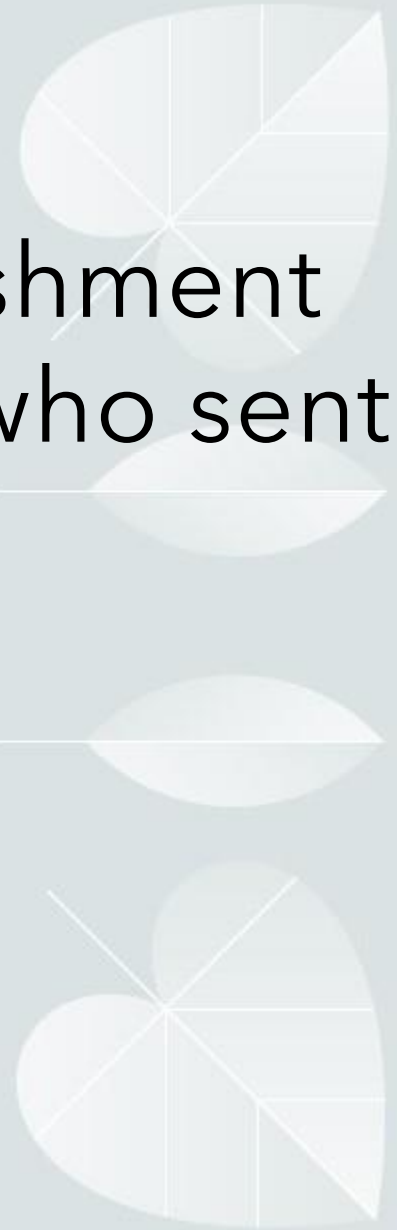
John 4:27-38

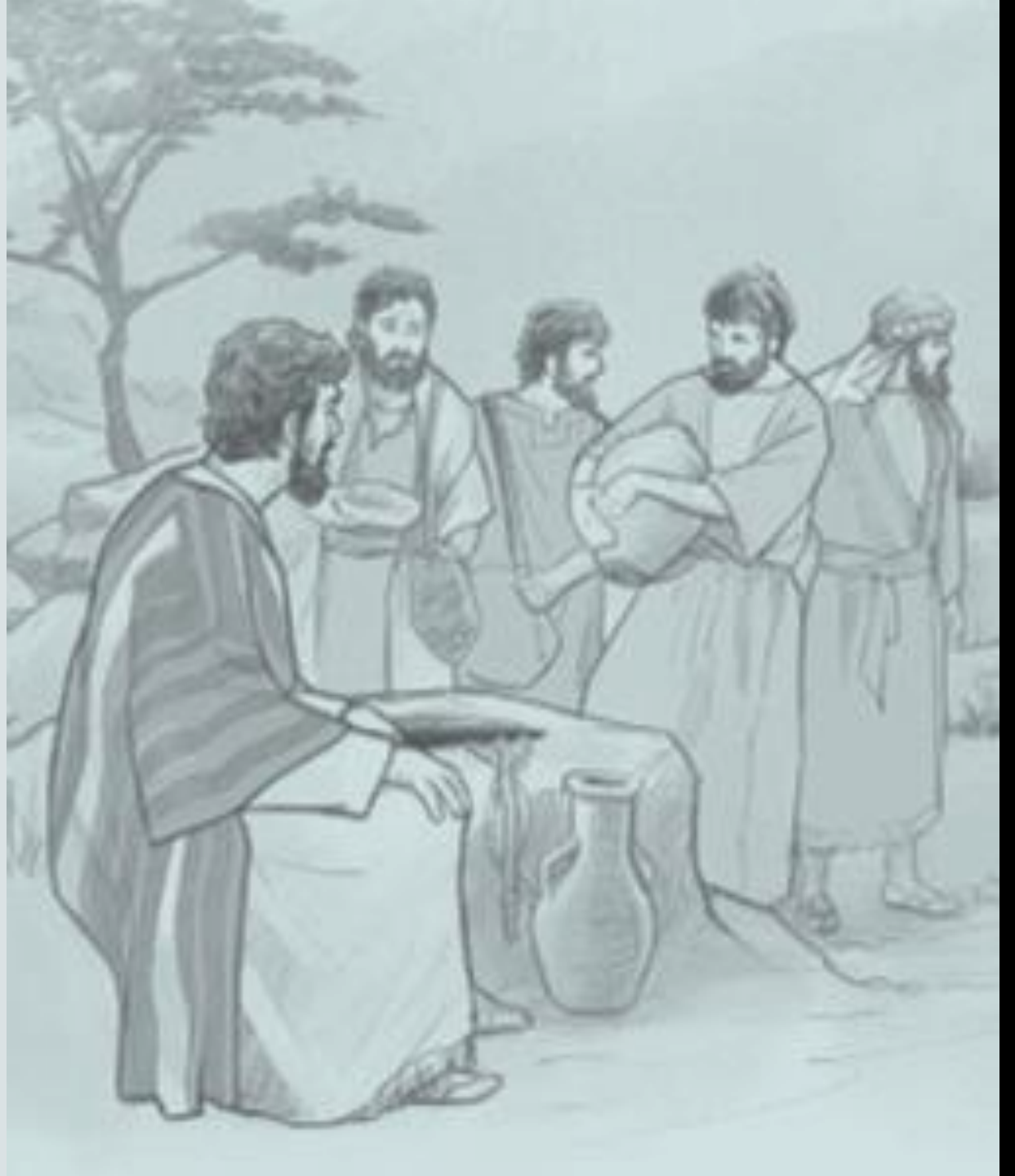

34 Then Jesus explained: "My nourishment comes from doing the will of God, who sent me, and from finishing his work."




