#### Parallel Truths

**Seemingly Opposing Truths that ar** found in the Bible that force us into a dilemma. The dilemma is that we must try to discern God's perfect will between two alternatives that are both biblically true.

God's Parallel Truths remind us that the Lord desires a personal, intimate relationship with each of His children more than He desires rule following.

### **Proverbs 26:4** Don't answer the foolish arguments of fools, or you will become as foolish as they are.

### Proverbs 26:5 Be sure to answer the foolish arguments of fools, or they will become wise in their own estimation.

God's Parallel Truths remind us that the Lord desires a personal, intimate relationship with each of His children more than He desires rule following.



When we are experientially confronted with two seemingly opposing truths that come from the Bible, our human nature is to cling to one and then ignore, exclude, or attack the other.



Parallel truths found in the Bible are meant to be held at the same time during the Holy Spirit led decision making process because they are meant to humble us and to make us fully dependent on the Lord.

**Appropriately handling the parallel** truths found in the Bible requires us to personally know God, to personally keep studying His story as He's told it, and to keep praying while we apply Holy Spirit led critical thinking.



- Our comfort is not important.
- Obedience is everything.
- He has His own perfect will, and it usually never matches up with ours.
- If we will not follow Him, He will replace us with others who will.



- He has no problem tearing down what He Himself started if it is no longer serving His intended purpose.
- He shows love to His enemies.
- His love for His created children will not stop Him from destroying them.

**Appropriately handling the parallel** truths found in the Bible requires us to personally know God, to personally keep studying His story as He's told it, and to keep praying while we apply Holy Spirit led critical thinking.

When it comes to discerning and choosing between parallel truths, it ultimately comes down to knowing the Father's heart, to hearing His voice, and to making your decision in faith.

### The Father's Heart

- Love your enemies.
- Bless those who persecute you.
- Turn the other cheek.
- Others will know that we are His disciples by the way we love one another.
- God wants everyone to be saved.

When it comes to discerning and choosing between parallel truths, it ultimately comes down to knowing the Father's heart, to hearing His voice, and to making your decision in faith.

So long as the Lord allows and so long as time permits, allow God to show you what His perfect will is. More often than not, God already has the perfect answer and we just need to take the time to listen to Him.
