

Matthew 3:13-17

1. Baptism demonstrates that I follow Jesus.

Matthew 3:13

Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be **baptized** by John.

John 10:27

My sheep **listen** to my **voice**; I know them, and they **follow me**.

2. Baptism demonstrates my need for Jesus.

Matthew 3:14-15

But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"

Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented.

3. Baptism demonstrates my belief that the Holy Spirit lives in me.

Matthew 3:16

As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him.

John 1:32

Then John gave this **testimony**: "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and **remain** on him.

John 1:33a

And I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me,

John 1:33b

'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.'

John 1:34

I have seen and I testify that this is God's Chosen One."

John 14:26

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

4. Baptism demonstrates my love for Jesus.

Matthew 3:17

And a **voice** from heaven said, "This is **my Son**, whom I love; with him I am well **pleased**."

John 14:23

Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.
