Learning to Be A **Follower** **of Jesus**

John 1:35-45

John 1:43-44

The **next day** Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, “**Follow me.**” ⁴⁴ Philip, like **Andrew and Peter**, was from the town of Bethsaida.

John 1:45

Philip **found** Nathanael and told him,
“We have found the one Moses wrote
about in the Law, and about whom the
prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth,
the son of Joseph.”

John 1:35-37

The next day John was there again with **two of his disciples**.³⁶ When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, “Look, the Lamb of God!”³⁷ When **the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus**.

2. Followers of Jesus **spend
daily-time** with Jesus.

John 1:38-39

John 1:38

Turning around, Jesus saw **them following** and asked, “What do you want?” **They said**, “Rabbi” (which means “Teacher”), “where are you staying?”

John 1:39

“Come,” he replied, “and you will see.” So they went and saw where he was staying, and they **spent that day with him**. It was about four in the afternoon.

3. Followers of Jesus find and tell others about Jesus.

John 1:40-41

John 1:40-41

Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus.⁴¹ The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ).

4. Followers of Jesus **bring
others to** Jesus.

John 1:42

John 1:42

And he **brought him to Jesus**.
Jesus looked at him and said, “You are
Simon son of John. You will be called
Cephas” (which, when translated,
is Peter).

John 6:8-9

Another of his disciples, **Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up,** ⁹ **"Here is a boy** with **five** small barley loaves and **two** small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"
