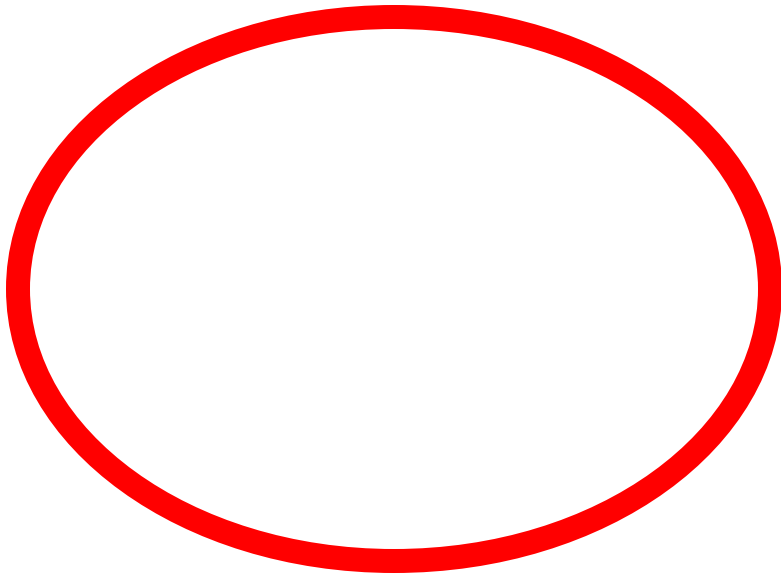

Naked a man comes from his mother's womb, and as he comes, so he departs. He takes **nothing from his labor** that he can **carry in his hand**.

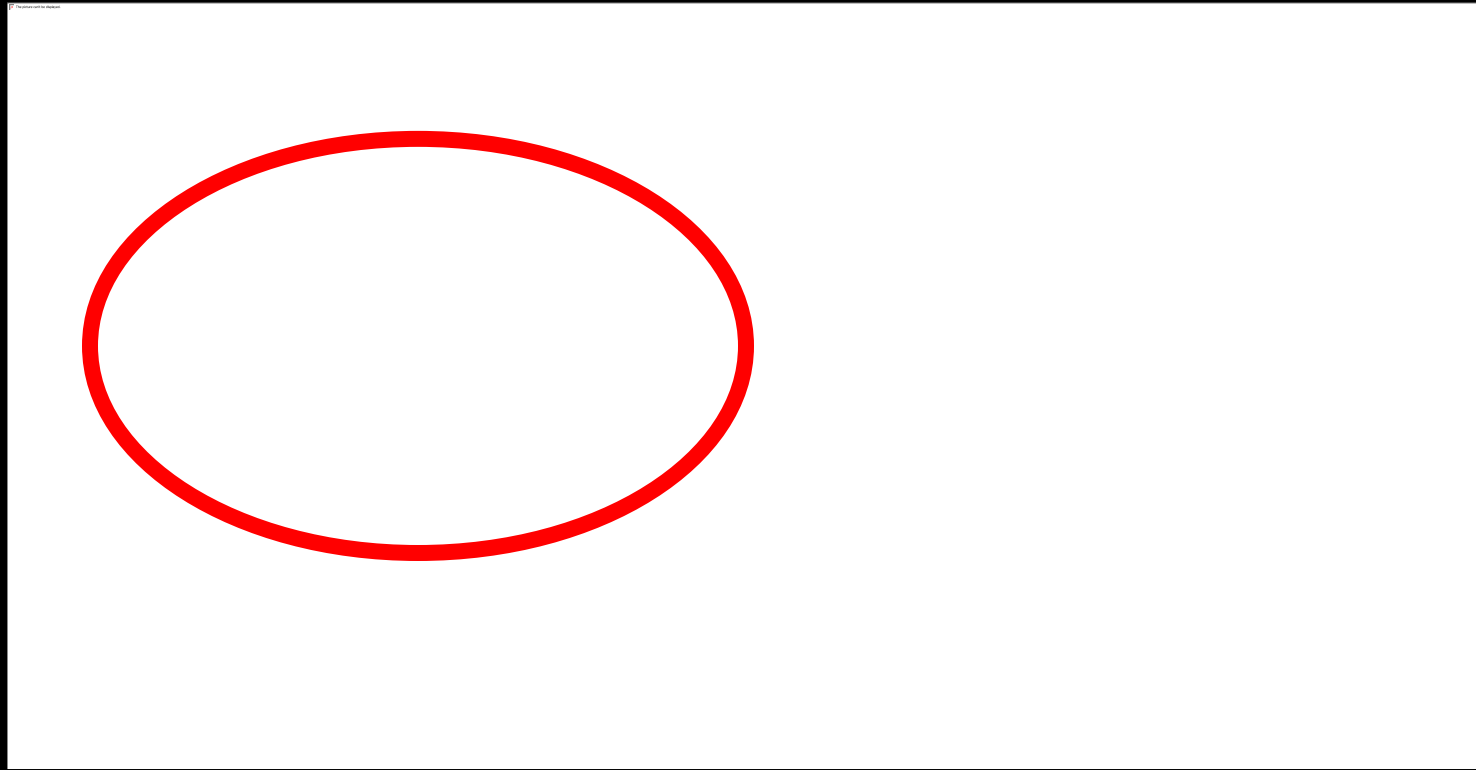
