# John 4:23

Yet a time is coming and has now come  
when the **true worshipers** will **worship**  
the Father in **spirit and truth**, for they are  
the kind of **worshipers** the **Father seeks**.

1. **Real worship** takes place  
**anywhere.**

**John 4:21**

## John 4:21

Jesus declared, “Believe me, woman,  
a time is coming when you will worship  
the Father **neither** on this mountain  
**nor** in Jerusalem.

2. **Real worship** is based upon  
**knowledge** of God's Word.

**John 4:22**

## John 4:22

You Samaritans worship what you  
do **not know**; we worship what we  
**do know**, for salvation is from the Jews.



3. **Real worship** is when I  
accept that **truth is a**  
**Person.**

**John 4:23-24**

## John 4:23-24

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the **true worshipers** will worship the Father in **spirit and truth**, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

<sup>24</sup>God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in **spirit and in truth.**”

4. **Real Worship** is expecting  
the Holy Spirit to **explain**  
His Word.

**John 4:25-26**

## John 4:25-26

The woman said, “I know that **Messiah**”  
**(called Christ)** “is coming. When he  
comes, he will **explain** everything to us.”

<sup>26</sup> Then Jesus declared, “**I who speak  
to you am he.**”

## John 16:12-13

“I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. <sup>13</sup> But when he, the **Spirit of truth**, comes, **he will guide you into all truth**. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

## John 16:14-15

He will bring glory to me by taking from what is **mine and making it known to you.** <sup>15</sup> **All that belongs to the Father is mine.** That is why I said the **Spirit** will take from what is mine and make it known to you.
