brother Sosthenes,

Your eyes saw my unformed body;
all the days ordained for me were
written in **your** book before one of
them came to be.

Hebrews 3:1

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters,
who share in the heavenly **calling**,
fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we
acknowledge as our **apostle**
and high priest.

**2. God called me to mature
into Christ likeness.**

1 Corinthians 1:2-3

1 Corinthians 1:2

To the church of God in Corinth, to those **sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be his holy people**, together with all those everywhere who **call** on the **name of our Lord Jesus Christ**—
their Lord and ours:

1 Corinthians 1:3

Grace and peace to you from God our
Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 1:5

The **Son is the image** of the invisible God, the firstborn over **all** creation.

Ephesians 4:14

Then we will no longer be **infants**,
tossed back and forth by the waves,
and blown here and there by every
wind of teaching and by the cunning
and craftiness of people in their
deceitful scheming.

Ephesians 4:15

Instead, **speaking the truth in love**,
we will **grow up** to become in every
respect the **mature** body of him who
is the head, that is, **Christ**.

1 Corinthians 1:10

I appeal to you, brothers and sisters,
in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,
that **all** of you **agree** with **one another**
in what you say and that there be **no**
divisions among you, but that you be
perfectly united in mind and thought.

Ephesians 4:1-2

As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the **calling you have received**.² Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, **bearing with one another** in love.
