## Romans 8:37

No, in all these things we are  
**more than conquerors**  
through **him** who **loved us.**

## Romans 8:28

And we know that in **all things God** works **for the good** of those who **love him**, who have been **called** according to **his purpose**.

2. The Father assures me that  
I'm being **transformed** into  
**Christ's image.**

**Romans 8:29-30**

## Romans 8:29-30

For those **God foreknew** he also **predestined** to be **conformed to the image of his Son**, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

## Romans 8:30

And those he **predestined**, he also **called**; those he **called**, he also **justified**; those he **justified**, he also **glorified**.

**3. The Father assures me  
God is interceding on my  
behalf.**

**Romans 8:31-34**

## Romans 8:31-34

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If **God** is for **us**, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> **He** who did not spare his **own Son**, but gave him up for us **all**—how will **he** not also, along with **him**, graciously give **us all** things?

## Romans 8:33-34

Who will bring any charge against those whom **God** has **chosen**? It is **God** who **justifies**.<sup>34</sup> Who then is the one who condemns? **No one**. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of **God** and is **also interceding** for us.

4. The Father assures me  
that nothing can **separate**  
me from God.

**Romans 8:35-39**

## Romans 8:35-39

**Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?** Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? <sup>36</sup> As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.”

## Romans 8:37-39

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. <sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,

## Romans 8:39

neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to **separate** us from the **love of God** that is **in** Christ Jesus our Lord.
